Qualified candidates will be added to our overhire list and will be called as work becomes available throughout our 2017 season. Responsibilities may include but are not limited to: carpentry, metal working, rigging, truck loading, load-ins, and load-outs.

Our Mission

Qualifications: Candidates should enjoy working in a diverse, creative, collaborative, and fast-paced environment. Candidates should have experience building and installing theatrical scenery. Knowledge of stage rigging and welding is a plus. Candidates must be able to repeatedly lift 50 lbs. and be comfortable working outdoors and at heights (ladders, genie lifts, catwalks, and truss). Ideal candidates will be team players with strong organizational, interpersonal, and time-management skills.

Special Environmental Factors: Theater is open-air with extended standing and walking on uneven surfaces. Work at the theater includes exposure to sunlight and hot weather for extended periods of time. Variable schedule, requires evening and weekend hours during load-ins and technical rehearsals. Some local travel between the scene shop in Berkeley and the theater in Orinda.

This position will remain open for the season.

Supervision: Carpenters report to the Shop Forman and Master Carpenter.
